



### Climatologist sees signs of looming drought

Saturday, March 3, 2012

According to Dr. Elwynn Taylor of ISU, several factors point to a dry planting and growing season:

- 1. La Nina continues and drier-than-normal spring and summer and wild temperature swings are typically associated with the weather phenomena
- 2. South Carolina endured a drought last year 16 of the last 17 major droughts in the Midwest started there
- 3. Northwest IA/Southern MN is in the midst of severe drought


